

All staff are trained and required to follow COVID Policy, Social Distancing, and Safety Protocols

All staff, volunteers, and club kids will complete COVID screening, use hand sanitizer, and have their temp taken and evaluated for COVID symptoms upon entering the club (fever, shortness of breath, loss of taste/smell, coughing, chills, sneezing, runny nose, headache, sore throat, or muscle pain)

Any staff or students that become ill will be immediately sent to the designated isolation room and sent home. This information will then be sent to the CPS principal, Club Director, and Club Executive Director for further assessment and Health Dept. guidance.

COVID policy is in place to track and monitor all quarantines or COVID testing

Club kids will be assigned stable groups with staff in each classroom

Any staff changes will be documented on the classroom sign-in sheets to track movement

Hand sanitizer and disinfectant will be located in every Club space

Club will be operating at 50% capacity at this time (25 at Derby, 25 Blue Ridge, and 50 at Alpha) and Main Club Site (125 K-12th) in assigned stable groups

No bus transportation will be offered at this time, some Club Van accommodations could be made

Some special programs will be offered but no field trips will occur at this time

Club kids will have their own program supply kits for programs to minimize sharing

No drinking fountains- kids must use personal identified water bottles

Club staff will use their own supplies for operations (pens, clipboards, sticky notes, devices, etc)

Social distancing will be promoted while entering, leaving, and participating in programs

Club kids will be picked up by parents outside of the club/school site (staff will use walkie talkies to communicate or club site telephone)

COVID safety policies, procedures, waiver, and communication is posted on our Parent Portal membership enrollment, Remind App texts, and BGC Website.

If the club has a positive COVID case the Club will be closed for 3 days to disinfect and communicate with health department and families regarding quarantines. Positive cases are protected under HIPPA privacy law.

Club kids will wash hands for 20 seconds and use sanitizer before and after eating dinner/snacks

Masks are mandatory for staff and during city ordinance for youth 10+ of age. Club will provide one then it is the parent's responsibility to launder and provide extras. Youth size disposables available too.

Club kids will be scheduled to go outside in stable groups for mask breaks
